What is the Forget Me Not Crafts challenge?

Forget Me Not Crafts challenge is a virtual craft challenge to create five or more forget me not themed crafts throughout May (1-31st) and raise £100 for Alzheimer's Society.

What if I've registered but have yet to set up my Facebook fundraising page?

How do I claim my medal?

When you have raised £100, we'll send you a medal in the post as a special thank you.

What is the Forget Me Not Craft pack?

We teamed up with Etsy crafters to create five quality templates for different Forget Me Not themed crafts. They contain all the instructions, images, and a handy video tutorial to get you started.

Either use the digital craft pack for inspiration or choose to make something entirely new.

Do I have to make five Forget Me Not Crafts?

We have recommended five crafts to reflect the five petals of the forget me not flower, but how many crafts you choose to make is completely up to you.

Each week, we will be sharing specific crafts from the pack to help guide you but feel free to drop us a message in the group if you need help adapting your challenge.



• Is there a minimum fundraising target?

Yes, we have recommended a target of £100. We're here to help you along the way! Either share your page with friends and family or chose to sell your crafts and donate your proceeds.

Why a Forget Me Not?

The forget-me-not is a small five petaled blue flower that represents remembrance. People with dementia may experience memory loss, among other symptoms. This makes the forget-me-not the perfect flower to represent our cause.

Do I have to set up a Facebook Fundraiser or can I fundraise another way?

You don't need a Facebook account to take part in this challenge. You can join our JustGiving campaign and set up a JustGiving page here: Forget Me Not Crafts - JustGiving

Remember to share updates and pictures to your page to let everyone know how your challenge is going.

How can I edit my Facebook fundraiser?

From the left menu on your News Feed, click Fundraisers.

Under Your fundraisers, find the fundraiser that you want to edit.

Click Edit Fundraiser.

You can edit the following elements on your page:

- 1. The amount of money you want to raise
- 2. Date fundraiser will end
- 3. Fundraiser title
- 4. Your reason for raising money
- 5. Cover photo



• How do I share my Facebook fundraiser with friends and family?

You can share your Facebook fundraiser in different ways, either:

- Use the 'invite' button at the top of your fundraising page to invite all your friends and family to see your fundraising journey.
- Share your Facebook fundraiser on social media and other platforms asking for donations from your friends, family, and colleagues.
- Copy the fundraiser link the share your page to Twitter, Instagram or LinkedIn.

How can I find my Facebook Fundraiser?

To find your Facebook fundraiser click 'Fundraisers' in the left menu of your News Feed on Facebook.

What do I do if I have two fundraising pages set up?

If both pages have donations on them then you can't delete either page or merge them. We suggest sharing the page with the most donations. If the second page has no donations, then you can always delete it.

I've reached my £100 target; how do I increase the target on my Facebook fundraiser?

That's amazing, thank you so much. To adjust your target on your page, complete these steps:

- Go to your Facebook fundraiser
- Click 'edit'
- Change your goal amount to your new target
- Click 'save'

What age group is this challenge suitable for?

To join the Facebook Group, you need to be over 18. Facebook fundraisers can only be set up by over 18s. If you wish to take part and are under 18, please ask a parent or guardian and fundraise through JustGiving: Forget Me Not Crafts - JustGiving

• Do I need to do anything once my challenge ends to make sure the funds go to Alzheimer's Society?

No, you don't need to do anything as all donations made via your Facebook fundraising page or your JustGiving page will automatically be sent to Alzheimer's Society.
